USER CHOICE PROGRAM

The User Choice program provides a public funding contribution towards the cost of training and assessment for eligible Queensland apprentices and trainees.

The program provides the flexibility for apprentices, trainees and their employers to select a preferred training provider (registered training organisation or RTO) from a list of Skills Assure Suppliers (SAS) for the delivery of accredited training to meet their specific needs. SAS are registered training providers who have contract with the Department of Employment, Small Business and Training to deliver funded training.

Demi Apprentices and Trainees is a registered provider under Queensland's User Choice program, enabling us to offer training and assessment services for apprenticeships at a reduced cost.

Eligible apprentices can choose to access this government funding or pay the full training cost directly.

A co-contribution fee applies for each unit of training delivered as part of the funding requirements. Concessional status, which may reduce these fees, is determined based on evidence provided during enrolment.

RTO ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

There are no entry requirements for this qualification. If the apprentice is under 18, a parent or guardian may be required to sign the training contract.

HOW TO APPLY

Start your apprenticeship in Certificate III in Barbering by following these easy steps:

- Secure an employer. An apprenticeship combines hands-on training with an employer and expert education from your training provider - us!
- Select Demi Apprentices and Trainees (DAAT) as your RTO at your AASN (Australian Apprenticeship Support Network) sign up
